Highlights of the month

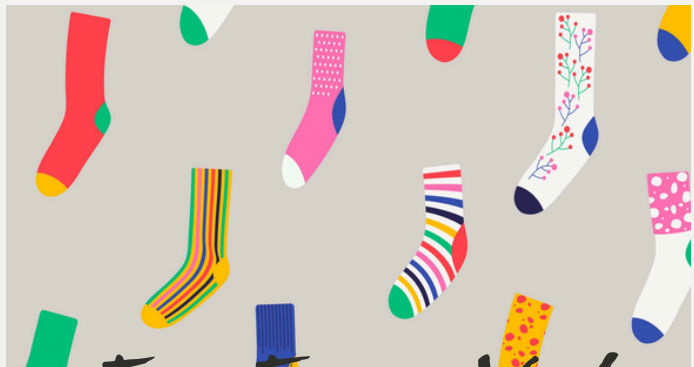
Remembrance Assembly - Year 5
