Highlights of the month

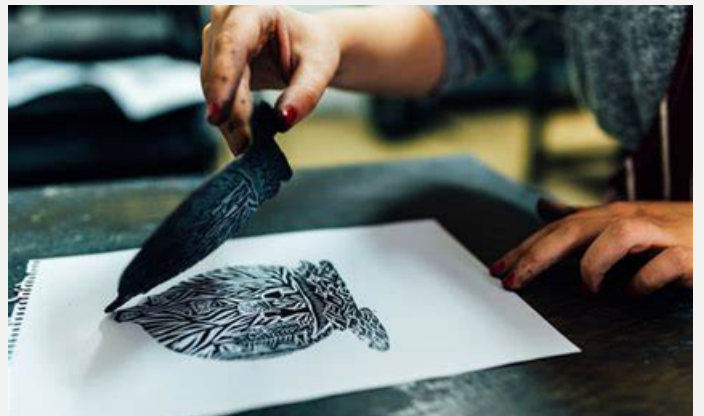


Year 6 SATS
